In an interview with Mick Fleetwood his journey into professionally showing his art started about ten years ago when a friend of his from an art gallery in Maui suggested that he show them. "Why would anyone want to see them?" he thought to himself. To his surprise when he started showing in LA there was a lot of great feedback and surprises from his fans. It should come as no surprise that Fleetwood would have the name and celebrity recognition to attract serious art buyers and collectors along with curious Fleetwood Mac fans. He likens his fine art photography as a way of "having an artistic commitment in a more organized way."

"I inherited my father's genes of being that annoying person with the camera . . . he was happy to take those family photos and nowadays we don't do it enough." As a world traveler, Fleetwood gets the opportunity to see a large part of the human experience where ever he goes. His inspiration and favorite style of photography is mainly in landscapes and the collection you will see at his showing include many landscapes along with close-up stills, nature and more. Having the ability to take photos in color and black and white, Fleetwood's style goes back to a time in history when photography was mainly about chronicling history or registering the existence of a building. More purpose rather than art. Today everyone has a camera in hand, whether it's on their phone or on another device.

Fleetwood's photography style mimics his musical style as a blues drummer. More about gut instinct and substance rather than technique. In his travels he may see a place or a shot and think to himself that he'd like to go back and capture that view again. Fans may be surprised that his art is rather quiet and serene different from the bold rocker of his music and band. This is what makes his photography style so engaging with audiences because there is a subtlety to it that catches the eye. Art lovers will enjoy this exhibit.
